10) Gion

Gion is a district of Kyoto, originally developed in the Middle Ages, in front of Yasaka Shrine. The district was built to accommodate the needs of travelers and visitors to the shrine. It eventually evolved to become one of the most exclusive and well-known geisha districts in all of Japan. The geisha in the Gion district (and Kyoto generally) do not refer to themselves as geisha; instead, Gion geisha use the local term *geiko*. While the term geisha means "artist" or "person of the arts", the more direct term *geiko* means essentially "a child of the arts" or "a woman of art".

11) Marumasu-Nishimuraya Tel 075 211 3273

Kyo-Yuzen is one of techniques kimono (traditional cloth in Japan). In the method, colorful designs such as seasonal birds, plants and landscapes are painted directly on the fabric. Because of their exquisite beauty, Yuzen kimono have remained popular from the end of the 17th century. As a studio for Kyo-Yuzen art, Marumasu-Nishimuraya has been following the techniques of Kyo-Yuzen since its inception more than 100 years ago. In addition to experiencing traditional crafts, our studio is a place to learn about Kyoto's culture and history at a Machiya (traditional wooden townhouse in Kyoto).
